The Montgomery County Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has identified the **Williamsburg Run Stream** in the Rock Creek Watershed for restoration. The existing conditions within Williamsburg Run Stream exhibit highly eroding stream banks with an incised stream channel that limits interaction between the stream and the adjacent floodplain.

The primary goals of the stream restoration are to stabilize the bank and bed of the stream, enhance floodplain connectivity, and reduce pollutants and sediment. Additionally, this project will significantly improve your community's environment by enhancing biodiversity, creating habitat, and improving water quality. By implementing natural stream restoration techniques on Williamsburg Run, we will be working to improve and maintain our water resources' ecological integrity, quantity, and quality.
